

The University of Worcester has a commitment to incorporate sustainability into its procurement activity. This is set out in the Procurement Strategy and is aligned to the University strategy. The university declared a Climate Emergency and has a commitment to be net carbon neutral by 2030 in a 1.5 degree warming scenario for scopes 1, 2 and 3 including procurement. The Sustainable Procurement Steering Group members will engage with University of Worcester Staff, Students and Suppliers to promote and integrate sustainable principles and practices within procurement activities across the University.
